Dear Students, Parents/Guardians:

Several of you have questions about the private school process. This letter explains that due to having no Guidance Counselors at the middle school level we cannot provide individual recommendations from Administrators. Your child is welcome to ask their English and Math teachers to provide recommendations as has been done in the past.

The three middle schools have written a "Middle School Profile" and a letter which will be mailed to the private school admissions office. This letter explains that due to having no Guidance Counselors at the middle school level the Administrative office will not be providing individual recommendations at the middle schools.

The process is as follows:

Students must complete and submit the following forms to the main office.

- 1. "List of Private Schools I Am Applying to" form:
 - a. Once complete return to the main office as soon as possible.
 - b. Provide a pre-addressed stamped envelope(s) for each school you are applying to.
- 2. "Transcript Release" form:
 - a. \$5.00 transcript fee for <u>each</u> school you are applying to; check made payable to: *Doherty Middle School* and return the completed form to the main office.
 - b. Parent signature is required on this form.
- 3. "What About Me" form:
 - a. Submit a completed copy of the "What About Me" form to each teacher that you ask to write a recommendation as soon as possible. This information will assist teachers as they write recommendations.
- 4. "Recommendations"
 - a. Student must first ask their English or Math teacher if they are willing to write a recommendation.
 - b. Student must provide the teacher will all necessary information they might find useful; such a name of school, deadline, etc...
 - c. Make sure to thank your teacher for their time and interest.

Should a student change his/her mind about applying to any or all schools, *PLEASE* let the teachers and the main office know. Teachers take these requests very seriously and spend considerable time on each recommendation and don't want to feel that they spent their time unnecessarily.
